




"Thinking globally, acting locally"

Children that are left without parental care against their will are a very unprotected and vulnerable part of society. These kids are no different that those who live in families: But left without a family or brought up by neglectful parents, they lose the aspect of a social life and close up within themselves. Over time, they convince themselves that they are "second class", and a normal fulfilling life with many prospects is not for them. Still living in orphanages, they prepare themselves for a criminal, wild, and irresponsible life which they believe is the only life they are capable of living. Over the course of many years we have

been putting on a week long camp for children ages 12-16. We tell them about the Gospel and by our own examples show them that they can live a new life in Christ. God works miracles! He destroys the lies of the devil in their hearts, making them new creations in Jesus Christ.
